**Memory Verse: Judges 6: 13** 

**Objective:** To remind us that God is consistent. When sin prevails, Israel remains powerless.

- 4. How deep was the deception back then, and what judgment was pending? **Judges 6: 10 13**
- 5. What were the reasons given for Israel's powerlessness? **Judges 6:** 1, Isaiah 59: 1 15
- 6. Presently, 'spiritual Israel' finds itself grappling with these same issues. If the Lord is to return to us, as in former times, what adjustments must be made? 1 Chronicles 15: 13 14, Ephesians 4: 17 24
- What real and sincere prayers would a loving God desire to hear from His people, and why? Psalm 27: 7 - 9, Ezekiel 18: 21 - 23
