6. What does the apostle Paul bring to this conversation? **Galatians 6: 1 - 4**
7. How do the apostles point to the way that brotherly love should be displayed between shepherds and sheep in this time? **Acts 20: 24 - 30, 1 Peter 5: 1 - 6, 1 Timothy 5: 1 - 3**
