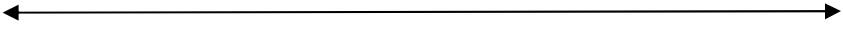


Subject: Grace, Faith and Works

5. What clear demonstration of this is made in **Matthew 19: 16 - 22**? And how does James lay this out? **James 2: 17 - 26**
6. How well did Zacchaeus understand this concept? **Luke 19: 1 - 10**
7. How relevant is the statement made to Israel in **Deuteronomy 7: 6 - 11**?
