5. Even though David was a king and comfortable in his own palace, how did he feel when there was not a permanent dwelling place for the Ark? **2 Samuel 7: 1 - 3**; And what was his desire? **2 Samuel 7: 4 - 6**
6. Identify the different ways in which David expressed himself regarding the house of God. **Psalm 122: 1, Psalm 84: 1 - 4 & 10, Psalm 27: 4, Psalm 96: 6**
7. The preacher of the Gentiles makes what significant request to us as believers? **Hebrews 10: 25**; Is anyone exempted from God's plan when it comes to gathering in His house? **Isaiah 56: 6 - 7**
