Subject: Christian Growth Scripture Reading: 2 Peter 3 Memory Verse: Hebrews 6: 1

Objective: To highlight the importance of Christian growth.

1. When Jesus was asked, "Who is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven," what was His response? **Matthew 18: 1 - 3**

Note: Like children, we must remain meek and teachable. This means coming to God and facing life with humility, fully aware that we do not have all the answers. Just as children look to their parents for guidance, provision, and correction, so we must rely completely on God's wisdom rather than our own understanding. True meekness allows us to be led, and a teachable heart keeps us open to continual growth in Him.
